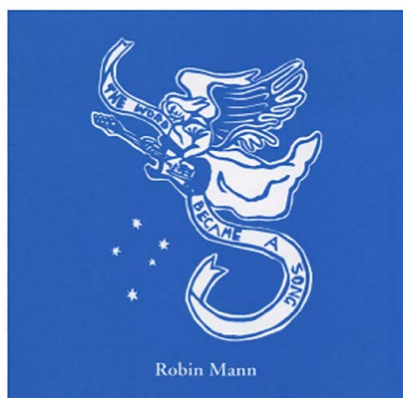

The song 'Now is The Time' challenges us to be part of the answer to the suffering in our world. *To everything there is a season and a time for every purpose under heaven.* The other songs beckon us to "stand up and be counted... and take some action", "head for your dreams in light" and "to know the reason we are gathered here... we've got to get up, get out." The album is a good display of Robin's broad range of songs - some for communities to sing together, two brief liturgical pieces, and musical stories and prayers. The mood ranges from the whimsical 'Included', the jokey Psalm 'Complaint in C', to the confessional 'Long the Hunters'. Musical styles vary from the cool Bossa Nova of 'Teach Me Your Way' to the big ballad 'She Washed His Feet With Her Tears'.
